1 County roads #2-16 & 2-18. Motion was made by George Carlon, seconded by
2 Don Fitzgerald to give the permit with great emphasis on the maintenance
3 part of the agreement. The District Attorney was instructed to draw up
4 the permit.

5 Motion was made by George Jackson, seconded by George Carlon that
6 if the Road Department Pugg Mill causes trouble this summer that Evert
7 Lawson have permission to purchase a new one.

8 The Commissioners were in favor of having Don Clause deputized
9 as Deputy Sheriff in order to keep security in the jail when he is visiting.

10 Motion was made by Don Fitzgerald that Dr. Wm. Strieby be
11 appointed as the County Health Officer for Lake County, seconded by George
12 Jackson with all in agreement.

13 The Zoning Amendments for Lake County were reviewed with the
14 following results: #1 - No, #2 - Yes, #3 - Yes, #4 - Yes, #5 - Yes, #6-No,
15 #7 - Yes. Amendments attached. Motion was made by George Carlon, seconded
16 by George Jackson that the zone change in Summer Lake was rejected in part
17 with a zone change to A-3 to include Paisley School District property located
18 west of store property. The East side of Highway 31 will remain the same.
19 Property located in Summer Lake owned by Jess Pendington was taken under
20 advisement.

21 Motion was made by George Carlon, seconded by Don Fitzgerald to
22 grant the raise of \$25 to Appraiser #2 in the Assessor's office effective
23 the first of May. All were in agreement.

24 The Commissioners wanted to go on record as being opposed to the
25 Wilderness P_roposal.

26 A Special Permit Agreement was submitted to the Board between Lake
27 County Board of Commissioners and Golden State Building Products authorizing
28 Golden State to operate log trucks on county roads # 2-16 & 2-18 from the 1st
29 of June, 1973 through the 15th day of November, 1973 subject to conditions
30 set forth in agreement and attached hereto. Agreement was signed by all three
31 members of the Board.
