

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE USE OF P.V.C. PIPE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF MAIN LINES IN THE LAKEVIEW SUBURBAN SANITARY DISTRICT, LAKE COUNTY, OREGON.

The Board of Directors of the Lakeview Suburban Sanitary

District does ordain as follows:

Section 1:

Adoption of the administrative rules of the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality regarding the use of P.V.C. pipe in the construction of main lines.

The administrative rules of the State of Oregon, Department

of Environmental Quality allowing the use of P.V.C. pipe in the con-

struction of main lines from the State of Oregon together with all

acts and amendments applicable thereto which are now or hereafter en-

acted, are hereby adopted and made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2:

The adoption pursuant to section 1 shall be the minimum re-

quirements for the use of P.V.C. pipe in the main lines of the Lakeview

Suburban Sanitary District, and the Board hereby reserves the right to

require a higher quality P.V.C. pipe than required by the State of

Oregon Department of Environmental Quality in the event the Board of

Directors determine that a higher quality pipe is necessary because of

special circumstances surrounding any particular main line installation

project.
