The Board of Commissioners of Lake County makes the following findings:

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 344 which became law as Oregon Laws 2009 Chapter 491, Section 1(2) provides that “unless an adopted county charter or county ordinance provides otherwise, the governing body of a county shall appoint a county surveyor”; and

WHEREAS, the previous law provided that surveyors in a general law county such as Lake are elected unless the voters adopt a measure making the surveyor an appointed official; and

WHEREAS, Lake County voters have not considered a ballot measure to make the county surveyor an appointed official; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds it appropriate to exercise the authority granted by Oregon Laws 2009 Chapter 491 and continue to allow the voters of Lake County to elect their surveyor;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners for Lake County enacts the following Ordinance:

Election of County Surveyor. Under authority of Oregon Laws 2009, Chapter 491, the position of Lake County Surveyor shall continue as an elected position.
