THE LAKE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the financial administration of the funds of Lake County need to be clarified and corrected, and;

WHEREAS, it is the belief of the Lake County Board of Commissioners that the financial administration of the County should be removed from the Office of County Clerk and placed under the direct supervision of the Lake County Board of Commissioners as is provided by law in ORS Chapter 210, and;

WHEREAS, It has been considered and found to be appropriate to transfer all financial administration matters from the Lake County Clerks Office to the Office of County Accountant as provided for in ORS Chapter 210;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, ADOPTED, AND ORDERED that effective July 1, 1999, all financial administration matters shall be and hereby are transferred from the Lake County Clerks Office into the Office of County Accountant

hereby created by this Ordinance and as provided for in ORS Chapter 210, and the said County Accountant's Office shall be responsible for all financial administration matters of the County as provided for in ORS Chapter 210.

The Department Head of the Office of County Accountant shall be known as the Lake County Financial Director.
