GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Performs a variety of skilled and manual tasks and operates dozers, CDL trucks, excavator, backhoe and other equipment in landfill construction and operation.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED Works under the supervision of the Landfill Foreman.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES

- Operate landfill equipment as needed (dozers, CDL trucks, excavator, backhoe and other equipment).
- Perform manual labor as needed: fence building, ditch digging, painting, litter picking and removal.
- Routine maintenance of landfill equipment; greasing, tire changing, etc.
- Coordinate both public and commercial haulers.
- Maintain records on time for equipment and landfill tonnage.
- Screen solid waste on tipping floor shed.
- Other duties as assigned by Foreman.

KNOWLEDGE OF

- Thorough knowledge of Dozer, Excavator, Trucks, Backhoe and other heavy equipment.
- Policies and procedures in landfill operations and/or material transfer

ABILITY TO

- Comprehend written and oral direction and instructions.

- Work safely, efficiently, independently and in a team.
- Perform strenuous physical tasks often.
- Maintain clean and concise records of equipment maintenance and landfill tonnage.
- Interact with public in a manner complimentary to Lake County.
- Change work priorities quickly, safely, and routinely.
- Complete routine maintenance of landfill equipment.
- Obtain First Aid and CPR Certification.
- Work in all weather conditions.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- Lift and carry up to 80 LBS occasionally.
- Sit for long periods of time often.
- Walk on steep and uneven ground often.
- Climb into and exit equipment often.
- Stand for long periods of time often.
