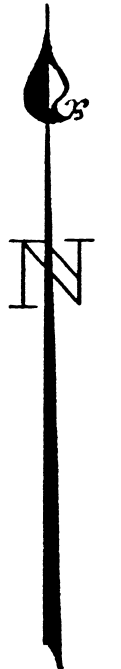
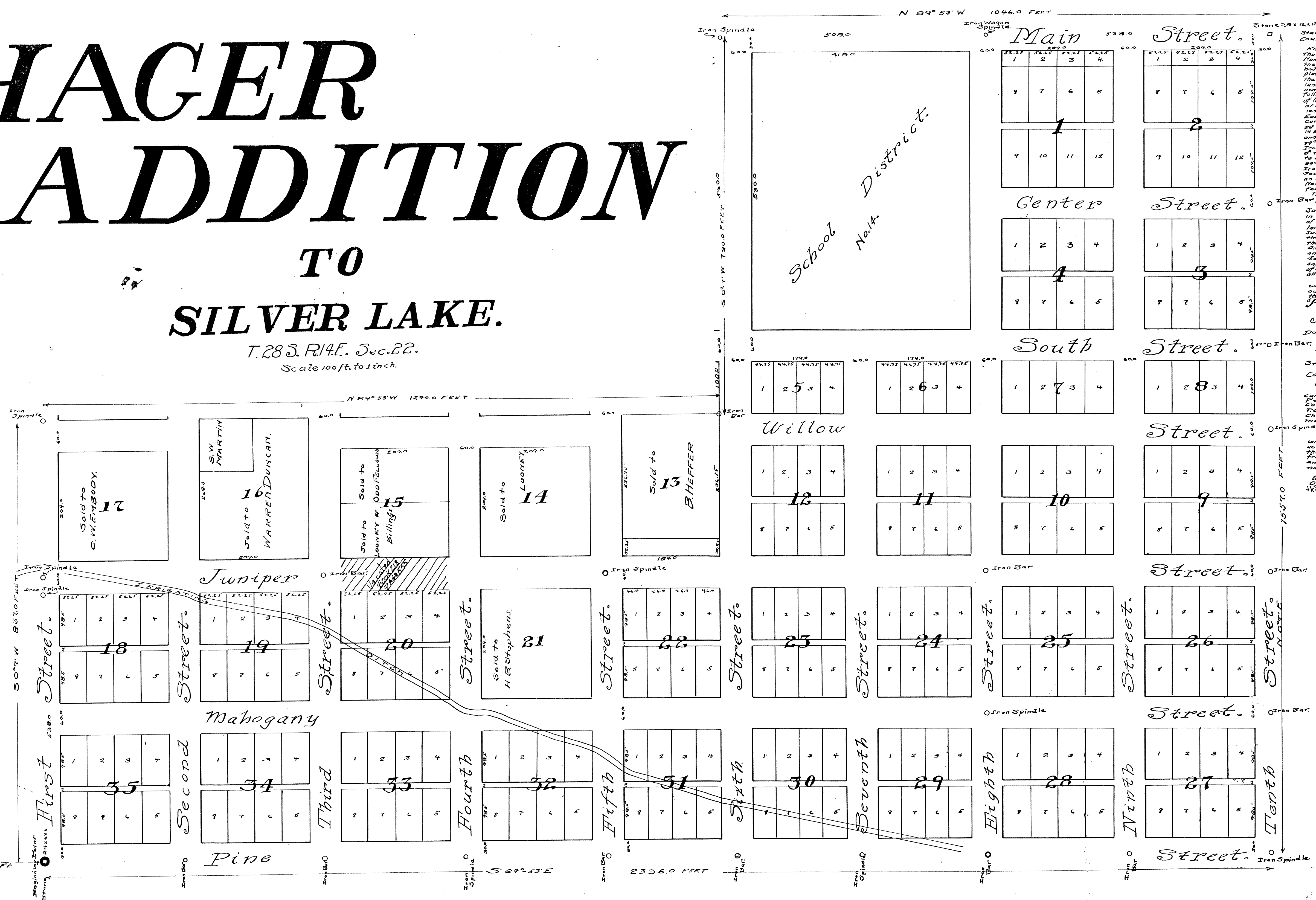


# HAGER ADDITION TO SILVER LAKE.

Know all men by these presents that I, F. C. Christman and Nancy Christman his wife, on the 5th day of December 1910 had survey made and plotted the Hager Addition to the town of Silver Lake upon the following described tract of land to-wit: Beginning at a stone which is North 1032.6 feet and South 775.5 feet from the corner of Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28 Township 28 South Range 14 East Willamette Meridian and running thence South 89° 53' West 2336.0 feet to an Iron Spindle, thence South 02° 14' West 720.0 feet to an Iron Bar, thence North 89° 53' West 1290.0 feet to an Iron Spindle, 100 feet to West of Beginning.

Said tract of land being in Lake County State of Oregon and having made, laid out and plotted the same by the within named F. C. Christman and Nancy Christman his wife to the names of the lots shown and plat same of and by these presents do hereby execute this some for the purposes of an addition subject to all legal regulations.
