Moon have on the 14th day of July 1877. had surveyed laid out and platted the North and South addition to the Town of Lakeview upon lands owned by me and in my possession and upon the following described lands to wit. The North Addition beginning at the North West corner of the Town of Lakeview (as acknowledged by me on the 25th day of May 1877) and from thence North 471 feet to a stake, thence East 576 feet to a stake and thence South 471 to a Rock at the North East corner of the Town of Lakeview and thence West 576 feet to the place of beginning, and likewise the South Addition beginning at the South West corner of the County Property deeded by M. W. Bullard to the County of Lake and from thence East 576 feet to a stake and from thence South 660 feet to a stake, and from thence West 576 to a stake and from thence North 660 feet to the place of Beginning. Said described Lands lying in Lake County State of Oregon, and I have made laid and platted the said North and South additions to the Town of Lakeview with streets as shown by the annexed Plat thereof, and by these presents I do hereby execute the same for the purposes of a Town Subject to all legal regulations.
