| Ag Advisory | Five members consisting of individuals knowledgeable of the Agriculture industry | Terms are ongoing | Meets as needed | To review process and conditions for annual validations of farm specially assessed land. |
| Airport Advisory | Five members consisting of one Commissioner, the Airport Manager, Town Manager, one business owner and one member of the general public. | Terms are ongoing | This committee will meet as often as necessary for a five month period. | The focus will be to review the existing Airport operation and facility. The long term goal is to develop a written 20 year airport-use strategy, and to update the existing Airport Master Plan. |
| BLM-County Grazing Board | Five member board consisting of individuals knowledgeable of grazing. | Two year terms | Meets as needed | To allocate the expenditures of grazing land receipts on approved range land improvement projects |
| Budget Committee | Six member board consisting of three County Commissioners and three members of the public | Three year terms | Meets annually | Review and provide recommendation to the Board of Commissioners on upcoming fiscal year budgets. |
| Christmas Valley Advisory | Seven member board consisting of members from Christmas Valley Fort Rock area | Ongoing | Meets as needed | Assist the Lake County Planning Commission in coordinating, land use planning for all lands situated in Lake County |
| Commission on Children and Families | Eighteen member board consisting of six student members, six members of the general public, one member of Municipal Government and five Superintendents | Four year terms | Meets ten times in a twelve month period. | To promote wellness for children of all ages and their families in the County, to mobilize communities and to develop policies. |
| Community College Advisory | Seven member board consisting of the general public | Three year terms | Meets as needed | To provide for and support continuing educational opportunities. |

| Community Development Loan Advisory | Minimum of five members – maximum of seven | Four year terms not to exceed one term | Meet as needed | . To provide incentive for continued and expanded economic development in Lake County |
| County Road Advisory | Six member board consisting of members of the general public | Ongoing | Meets annually | To discuss County road conditions and review work performed during the previous year. Also reviews and provides recommendations regarding new projects brought before them |
| Cultural Trust | Eight member board consisting of members of the general public. Also includes a County Commissioner as a Liaison | Three year terms | Meet as needed | To protect, present, promote and preserve Lake County's arts, heritage and humanities |
| Elected Official Compensation Review Committee | Three member board consisting of members of the general public | Two year terms | Meet annually | Provide salary recommendations to the Budget Committee for Elected Officials |
| Fair Board | Five member board consisting of one County Commissioner and four members of the general public | Three year terms | Meets every 2 nd Tuesday of each month @ 6:00 pm at the Fairgrounds Office | Provide for events, competitions and entertainment for Lake County taking place at the Fairgrounds |
| Forest Land Classification Committee | Six member board consisting of one OSU Extension Service rep., one Fire Marshal rep., and four others | Four year terms | Meet as needed | To assist the Department of Forestry and Forestland Classification |
| Health Insurance Committee | Seven member board consisting of County Employees | Open term dates | Meets annually | Reviews the County's health and life insurance plans and provides recommendations to the Board of Commissioners |
| Local Public Safety Council | Twelve member board consisting of representatives from all safety related agencies. | Ongoing | Meets as needed | To provide and update safety procedures and identify issues within the County |

| Mental Health Advisory | Thirteen member board consisting of representative from related agencies or commissions | Three year terms To begin on January 1 and to expire on December 31 | Meets the first Wednesday of each month | To provide assistance in education and support to Mental Health and review annual budget |
| Museum Board | Five member board consisting of members of the general public | Ongoing | Meets as needed | Accept deeds, gifts, devises or bequests of land, money or other valuable items in the name of Lake County. This board also maintains and operates the Lake County Museum |
| Planning Commission | Seven member board consisting of members of the general public | Four year terms | Meets every third Tuesday of each month | To evaluate and decide how land is to be used in Lake County |
| Board of Property Tax Appeals | Three member board consisting of one County Commissioner and two members of the general public | One year terms | Meets annually | To hear and to make decisions on Property Tax Appeals. |
| Railroad Advisory | Eight member board consisting of one County Commissioner, Town of Lakeview representative, four members effected industry and one member of the general public | Ongoing | Meets quarterly with additional meetings as needed | Long-term goal is to ensure adequate involvement from impacted local government entities and users of the line to review operation and maintenance of Lake County Railroad. |

| Security Facility Safety Committee | Twelve member board consisting of County employees working within the Courthouse and two members of the general public | Ongoing | Meets once per month (possibly migrating to once per quarter) | To review work place security and safety issues as necessary and review existing office and storage space utilization. |
| Special Transportation Committee | Seven member board consisting of the public based on ODOT requirements | Ongoing | Quarterly as needed | Review provider proposals, recommend level of funding |
| Vehicle Advisory | Five member board consisting of one County Commissioner and four dept. heads | Ongoing | Quarterly as needed | Review non-road dept. fleet performance advise on purchasing needs |
