## **County Update**

The Courthouse and Annex buildings will operate with essential staff and services the week of March 23 – March 27. However, public access will be limited. The majority of services will be offered by phone or via web. Appointments will be allowed with the department if time sensitive. That department is required to have the person entering the building to answer the screening questionnaire. The Court will be processing arraignments as needed. Jurors will still call into the information every Friday for further information. A meeting will be held on the 27<sup>th</sup> to determine public access the following week.

## **School Updates**

### Paisley School District

As of yesterday, we are following the directive for school closure. We plan on staff returning on March 30, at which time we will determine our method of operation for the month on April. We will have an instructional model based on information about what is allowable. That information has been promised by the Director of the Oregon Department of education next week.

We are providing sack lunches for students who request them. By the return of staff on the 30<sup>th</sup>, our building will be sanitized and ready for the minimal occupation we expect to be the new normal for a while.

We are waiting for a board meeting Monday evening to determine the status of our international students. There is a “strong recommendation” from the agency placing them to have them return home. Our board will determine whether or not to support them completing the year. Of course, this could change at any time, as there are other folks involved in their fate (the federal department of state; the state of Oregon; the operational aspects of the airlines; and, most importantly, the families of the students).

### North Lake

As of now we are obviously closed. However, my staff worked Monday and Tuesday this week.

Elementary: Teachers prepared envelopes with work for students for perhaps a week. Many made phone calls to parents as we anticipated at least part of a closure extension.

Secondary: we have one to one Chromebook and staff prepared lessons thru Google Classroom to keep kids current.

We can continue this process but now with the extended closure we may adjust as needed.

The Executive Order funds “as if students were present” and allows us to call in staff as needed (as long as it is safe). I will meet with barraging group leaders and explore what is practical and prudent for teachers to come in. We are waiting for further direction from ODE to see if we can gather small groups of kids for instruction. Still lots of questions.

Like the State, we will priorities and look at seniors and their graduation status.

### Lakeview School District

Gov. Kate Brown has extended the statewide closure for K-12 schools through April 28. We know this is a trying time and the closure of our schools is a challenge to many families.

We understand and share your concerns, and the district is working to address them. The situation continues to not only change by the day, in most cases by the hour. With every new announcement, the Oregon Department of Education must determine what actions school districts need to be taken.

The Governor has mandated that during the closure we provide a program of supplemental education program for all students, and food service. At this time, we are still working on the details of both these programs at the high and middle school levels awaiting further guidance from the Oregon Department of Education. The elementary schools have a preliminary plan in place that is being released to all elementary parents today. In the meantime, we are encouraging families to enjoy their scheduled spring break.

At this time, LCSD#7 has implemented the following steps:

- 1) All of our facilities are minimally staffed, including the District Office. If you need to contact the District Office for any reason, please do so by phoning 541-947-3347, and we will either personally assist you, or leave a voice mail and we will return your call. You may also email me

at [cahillw@lakeview.k12.or.us](mailto:cahillw@lakeview.k12.or.us). See your individual child's school letters for details on 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter grades, contact information, and hours of operation during closure.

- 2) Our custodians will continue cleaning our schools and ensure they remain disinfected for when students and staff return.
- 3) The district will offer its free meal program from Wednesday April 1 until school resumes. Details on locations and times will be sent to you through your building principals through School Messenger, and the District Facebook page.
- 4) Continue to check our webpage, and the LCSD #7 Facebook page for updates.

Please be assured that we want what is best for our students and families. We appreciate your understanding as we navigate this constantly changing situation.
